Nonie Darwish, a Muslim raised in Gaza and Egypt, graduated from the American University in Cairo and worked as an Editor/Translator at the Middle East News Agency. Her father led the Palestinian Fedayeen, which was responsible for killing 400 Israelis. As a child, she was taught to hate Israelis and Jews. Today, she is a founder of *Arabs for Israel*, an outspoken Arab feminist, and author of *Now They Call Me Infidel: Why I Renounced Jihad for America, Israel, and the War on Terror*.
