- * There was a good balance between theory and practice (case) and I don't see any need for course improvement.
- * A lot of materials to cover, but still worth it!
- * Fewer cases
- * The only nagging item about this class was the hours. I believe the class was supposed to be 2.75 hrs. However, Prof Soo often lectured for almost 3. After 2.75 hrs, quantity begins to exceed quality in terms of absorption of the material. Perhaps keeping the class to 2.75 hrs would be more beneficial.
